Greg McIntosh. The theme for members to share is "October 31" and the theme for the Print Competition is *MACRO*.

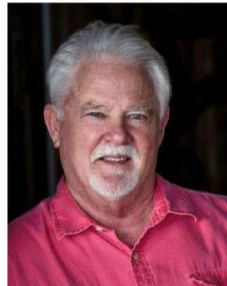

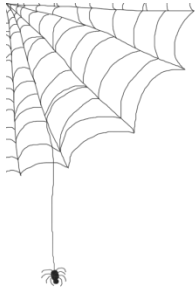

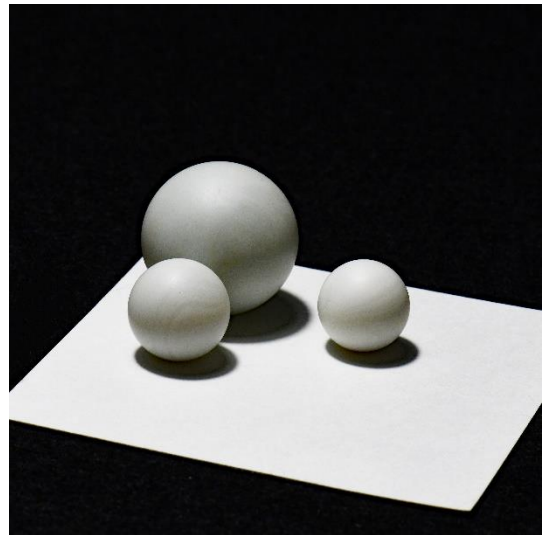
