

Best Picture of the Year:

The Board agreed to award 1st, 2nd, 3rd and an Honorable Mention to the three BPOY competition categories (Color, Monochrome and Special Technique). The BPOY will then be selected. It was further agreed that there will be a limit of eight 2018 ribbon entries per member. In addition there will be a people's choice award.

Vero Beach Museum of Art Juried Photography Exhibition:

The Board agreed that each entering photographer will be allowed to enter up to five images. There will be \$15 fee per entry. IRPC members will be given a fee waiver on their first entry. It was further agreed that entries with printed messages will be prohibited. There will be a first place ribbon awarded in each of the seven categories and a Best in Show award.
