April's 2024 Speaker Kim Hunt



Kim Hunt was born and raised in central New Jersey. Her interest in photography began in high school and rapidly grew into her passion in life for over 42 years. She earned a Bachelor of Arts degree from Rutgers University in psychology and photography. She worked as a professional photographer and earned her way up the corporate ladder as a district manager supervising 23 professional portrait studios in New York, New Jersey and Pennsylvania. The

photo company concept was innovative utilizing traditional film in medium format cameras with printed images within an hour.

She continued to pursue her interests in creative, alternative photographic processes through ongoing workshops which include Polaroid transfers, Polaroid emulsion lifts, Polaroid SX 70 manipulation, Cyanotype, Van Dyke Brown, infrared, hand colored black and white prints, painted liquid emulsion, pinhole cameras, encaustic wax photo transfers, etc. Her artwork has been hand printed on different mediums such as tile, glass, wood, silk, acrylic, metal, watercolor paper, muslin fabric, etc.

Kim has also traveled the world to explore different cultures with her cameras in India, China, Kenya, Dubai, Russia, Italy, France, Finland, Norway, Greece, Iceland, Spain, Turkey, Mexico, Aruba, Bahamas, etc.

In 2003, she graduated with a Master of Fine Arts degree in photography from Barry University.

Kim has taught photography at Barry University, Eastern Florida State College, Palm Beach Photographic Center, Adult Continuing Education, Brevard Cultural Alliance, Camera Club of Brevard, Indian River Photo Club, photo camps for kids, K-8th grade, middle school and for at-risk youth.

Her photographs have been exhibited and published in the Sun Sentinel newspaper, View Camera magazine, City Link advertisements, the Palm Beach Photographic Center, the Society of Photographic Art, the Alliance Française of Miami, Barry University, Vero Beach Museum, Fifth Avenue Art Gallery and juried photo competitions.






