Then we took another step for a new adventure. We drove up to Alaska and fell in love with the people and wildlife. We learned so much about Bears from friends that made a I Maxx movie about bears. They took us so many places in their float plane to be with the bears. Some of my photos were in galleries, local shops and hotels. I had a full page in Camera Arts

magazine. My photos were used in Europe for advertising in magazines. We moved back to Florida and started to sell our work at a farmers' market. We were very surprised that we sold so many each day. Today I am on the computer for hours late at night like I did on my drawing board when I was a designer. I cannot wait to see what I shot that day. We are still hiking steep mountains, although carrying our gear is getting harder to do. But I have to say smart phones may not be good for wildlife, but they sure are great for portraits, still life and landscapes.
